WHEN A BOROUGH HOLIDAY IS OBSERVED ON A SCHEDULED GARBAGE COLLECTION DAY, GARBAGE WILL BE COLLECTED ON FRIDAY OF THAT WEEK FOR THE ZONE THAT FELL ON THE HOLIDAY

CURBSIDE YARD WASTE COLLECTION OCCURS APRIL THROUGH OCTOBER

**THE BOROUGH WILL CONTINUE TO COLLECT LEAVES THROUGHOUT THE BOROUGH AS WEATHER PERMITS.
TREE LIMBS AND BRUSH CLIPPINGS MUST BE CUT IN 4 FOOT (4') LENGTHS AND BUNDLED.
LEAVES & YARD WASTE MUST BE BAGGED OR PLACED IN A CONTAINER.**

CURBSIDE RECYCLING SCHEDULE

WHAT CAN YOU RECYCLE AT CURBSIDE?

- **Newspapers**

Do not bundle or tie. Keep separate from mixed paper/magazines and keep dry. Inserts can remain.

- **Mixed Paper/Magazines**

Includes office paper, junk mail, glossy paper, magazines, colored paper, envelopes, coupons, phone books, paperback books, etc. Separate from newspapers and keep dry. Bag shredded paper.

- **Corrugated Cardboard**

Look for the ridges inside the layers of a corrugated cardboard box. Break down boxes and keep dry. No paperboard (cereal, macaroni, or tissue boxes, etc.), wax cardboard, or food/grease soiled cardboard. **REMOVE ALL PACKING MATERIALS**

- **Aluminum Cans & Foil**

Please empty and rinse your cans. Thoroughly clean foil, **NO FOOD RESIDUE**. Crushing cans is optional, but saves space.

- **Steel or "Bimetal" Cans**

Rinse cans well and secure the lid inside. **NO FOOD RESIDUE**. Labels can remain.

- **Glass Bottles and Jars**

Separate glass bottles and jars by color; clear, brown, and green. Food and beverage containers only. **NO FOOD RESIDUE**. Remove all lids and rings and rinse well. Labels can remain.

Windows, light bulbs, windshields and cookware are all made of a different type of glass and are not accepted.

- **Plastic Bottles, Jugs, Jars & Tubs**

RECYCLE PLASTICS BY SHAPE, NOT BY THE #

Includes soda and water bottles, milk jugs, laundry jugs, shampoo bottles, yogurt containers, and butter tubs. Rinse well. **NO FOOD RESIDUE**, labels and caps can remain.

Crushing your plastic containers helps to save collection space. It is acceptable to bag plastics for curbside collection.

RECYCLING AND COMPOSTING CENTER

Public Works Shed 321 S. Thomas Avenue (next to Riverfront Park).

The Borough has set up a distribution area there where residents can load their own compost. Compost is not available to contractors and it cannot be loaded with a bucket loader. The compost distribution area will be filled periodically and it is available free of charge.

What can I bring to the Composting Section?

- Leaves
- Grass
- Garden residue
- Woodchips
- Tree limbs less than four inches in diameter.

What can you recycle at the Recycling and Composting Center?

The Recycling Center takes everything listed above under Curbside Recycling (including the same restrictions), plus:

- PAPER PRODUCTS: Office paper, junk mail, glossy paper, coupons, fax paper, envelopes, phone books, etc.

E-RECYCLING – NORTHERN TIER SOLID WASTE AUTHORITY WILL NO LONGER ACCEPT ELECTRONIC DEVICES IN ITS WASTE STREAM AS PER STATE REGULATIONS.

These devices are now considered recycling and must be dropped off at a recycling center. Sayre Borough Recycling Center does not accept any electronic devices.
